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WATER POLLUTION RESEARCH AND CONTROL, Brighton

Part 5 of the Proceedings of the Fourteenth Biennial Conference of the International Association on Water Pollution Research and Control, held in Brighton, UK, 18–21 July 1988

For the IAWPRC 14th Biennial Conference there were some substantial changes to the traditional scientific programme format. The IAWPRC Specialist Technical Groups played a much larger part by organizing a number of specialized seminars, in addition to the general sessions, and the number of parallel sessions was increased to a maximum of six. The Conference proceedings thus contain papers on a wide range of subjects related to water pollution research and control, which should be of interest to both generalists and specialists.

Part 5 contains summaries of the discussions of the papers presented in the various sessions of the whole Conference. The texts of these papers are contained in Parts 1–4 of these proceedings. Also included here are poster presentations on the following subjects: Activated Sludge Systems; Ponds/Vegetation; Anaerobic Treatment; Activated Carbon; Nutrient Removal; Ozonation/Odour Control/Disinfection; Aerobic Biofilms/Bioadsorption; Sedimentation/Sludge; Stormwater Overflows; Management/Systems Analysis/Modelling; Industrial Wastewater Treatment; Pollutants: Behaviour/Effects/Measurement.

The material incorporates aspects of both research and practice in water pollution control, and contains valuable information for the abatement of water pollution and the enhancement of the quality of the water environment worldwide.

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
